

Course Policies

- Appropriate golf attire is required at all times. Shirts and shoes required at all time
- Only food and beverages purchased at Bluff Creek are allowed - No personal coolers
- Each player must have a set of clubs
- Only 2 players per cart - Must have valid DL to operate golf cart
- Please keep carts 30 feet from tees and greens. Stay on paths when provided. Please keep carts out of all native grass areas
- Please leave rakes in bunkers after use
- Portable Restrooms are available on holes #5,#8,#14,#16

Conditions Of Play

Define Penalty Area: All Native Grass areas / edges of grass/brush height taller than rough height will define penalty areas. Edges of Rocks around water areas will define penalty area.

Define Out of Bounds White Stakes on Holes #1, #18 will define OB. The inside edge of fence posts at ground level on hole #8, #9, #15 will define OB. No relief from fence posts.

Local Rules :

- Drop Area on Hole #12 is for any shot attempt trying to clear ravine in front of green. 1 stroke penalty
- Black Stakes around Maintenance shed define abnormal ground conditions. Free relief
- Fence on hole #1 and #14 are obstructions. Free relief for swing and stance, not flight

We are a Modern Local Rule E-5 Course

When a player's ball has not been found or is known or virtually certain to be out of bounds , or LOST BALL the player may proceed as MLR E-5 rather than proceeding under stroke and distance . Find reference point, no nearer hole, Drop w/ 2 Stroke Penalty.
